Practice writing your numbers 0-10 with a wet paintbrush somewhere outside.	Make a recipe with the help of an adult. Remember to measure out your ingredients!
Use scissors to cut out five things in your favorite color. Use a glue stick and glue them onto a paper.	Play Hopscotch or Follow the Leader with a family member or a friend.	Get out a drawer of 10-20 items and sort them into two different groups.	Sing the ABC song a few times each week in the summer. Slow down when it comes to L,M,N,O,P.
Can you think of five words that begin with a B? Have an adult help you write them.	Tell someone three words that rhyme with cat and fan.	Go outside on a sunny day and trace your shadow. Go out the same day an hour or two later, in the same place, and trace your shadow. What happened?	Draw a picture of your house and you standing outside.
Play with Play-Dough or something similar. Try to make letters or numbers with it. Roll it in balls and snakes.	Go to church and meet our new priest!	Practice saying the Prayer Before Meals that begins, "Bless us O Lord and these thy gifts.."	Practice writing all of your uppercase letters in shaving cream or salt!
